1995-2009	Travel Growth: Expansion of Low Cost Airlines and unregulated air travel. Open Door Migration: Mass migrations into Australia, NZ and into and within the EU. Religious Theory: Growth of terrorism & militant fundamentalism. US & UK leaders, Bush & Blair claim God sent them to war. Sport Development: New power and wealth to international sports stars especially soccer. Imperial Delusions: UK focus on large projects, foreign religious wars and national interest with common threat. Imperial Growth & Extravagance: US focus on war on terrorism, fear of foreign religion & neglect of debts to far east due to heavy consumption & low production. Knowledge Growth: Encyclopedia Britannica (the most famous printed Encyclopedia) eclipsed by Wikipedia Imperial Expansion: Australia drawn into war on terror.	2008-2024	Travel restricted on environmental grounds. New, cleaner means of transport developed. Immigration Control: Selective immigration based on skills and quotas. Religious Practice: Less religious terrorism, more political and economic pressure and control from Islamic States. Islamic Imperialism. Sport Regulation: New rules restoring control of ownership, transfer of players and endorsements to clubs and promoters. End of Empire: Kingdoms of the British Isles start to set up home rule, leading to the break up of the UK as a single country. End of Empire: End of supremacy of the US as a super power and the Dollar as the world currency. Re-emergence of China and India. 2010 US alliances change radically. Practical Knowledge: Educational emphasis on useful skills away from liberal arts. Government Control of Information & Internet. Start of Empire: Australia takes a more powerful, but less traditionally allied international role in UN. Shift to Labor Premier.
